At the end of the day, week or month, the candle for that time period is finalized. A candlestick consists of the body with an upper or lower wick or shadow. Most candlestick

charts show a higher close than the open as either a green or white candle. The opening price as the bottom of the candle and the closing price as the high of the candle. Also, most candlestick charts show a lower close than the open represented as a red or black candle, with the opening price as the top of the candle body and the closing price as the low of the candle body. ...and much more!
